Dear Beale Family:

We often think of the Gospels, but have you considered the book of Acts recently? Acts is one of two books in the Bible written by Luke, the physician (of course, inspired by the Holy Spirit). If I can

use an old joke, I wonder how anyone was able to read his original manuscripts, being a doctor and all....

As we begin the post Easter season in the church, this might be a wonderful time to re-read Luke-Acts. Both books are filled with stories, parables, sayings and truths that show us the life of Jesus and the life of the early church. The interesting thing about Acts is that while it ends, it ends in an awkward place, as if to show us that the story of Acts really doesn't end because it is the story of the Body of Christ – the church!

Acts continues the themes of action, drama and persecution that were so much a part of Jesus' ministry, as if to remind us too that the Body of Christ (the church) really is the representative of Jesus to the world – and the world is going to treat the church the same way it treated Jesus.









